A legacy gift is a donation made through your will, trust, or estate plan.

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### Why should I consider a legacy gift?

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### Types of legacy gifts include:

- A gift in your will or living trust
  - A residual gift (what's left after other bequests are made)

  - Gifts of property
  - Charitable trusts
